An annual subscription to the Journal of Liberal History costs £25.00 (£15.00 unwaged) for individuals with UK postcode addresses, or £35.00 (£25.00 unwaged) for addresses outside the UK. This pays for a printed copy sent by post of each issue published during the subscription period. For access online during the period to pdf versions of the current and previous nine issues of the Journal, as well as a printed copy of each issue, the annual subscription is £45.00 for all addresses (no reduction for unwaged). We also welcome donations towards our publishing and research work. The subscription includes membership of the History Group unless you inform us otherwise.

The subscription year for individual subscribers starts on 1st October, but subscriptions commencing after 30th June continue until 30th September in the following year without further payment. Subscribers receive all issues of the Journal published during the subscription year; those joining before 1st July are sent any issued since the previous 1st October.
